Contest Guidelines

Eligibility

- Students must have a cancer connection and live in Bucks, Montgomery, Philadelphia, Delaware or Chester Counties
- Middle School contest is for 6th 8th grades.
- High School contest is for 9th 12th grades.

Entry Rules

- Each student may submit only one original essay authored by the student.
- Parent permission required.
- Digital photo required.
- Middle School contest 500 750 words.
- High School contest 750 1500 words.
- Include essay title at the top of each page.
- Do not include your name on the essay.

All essays and photos will be posted on our website.

Essay Deadline

- Digital entry form, essay and photo must be submitted by Monday, April 4, 2022.

- Use QR code for submission form
- Late entries will not be accepted.
