

30 YEARS STRONG

Over the past 30 years, Cancer Support Community Greater Philadelphia has served over 500,000 people in our region. We provide a supportive community that fosters emotional support and promotes active engagement in one's cancer treatment,

Our service design followed Dr. Harold Benjamin's vision of the Wellness Community in Los Angeles, where Gilda Radner, famed for her roles on Saturday Night Live, found solace during her battle with cancer. After Gilda's passing her husband, Gene Wilder, and psychotherapist, Joanna Bull established Gilda's Club, expanding similar services nationwide. In 2009, Gilda's Club Delaware Valley and The Wellness Community of Philadelphia merged with Cancer Support Community (CSC) yet operated independently until 2014, when we officially became Cancer Support Community Greater Philadelphia (CSCGP).

Since our merger, we have experienced significant growth, a testament to the increasing need for our services. Approximately 9,000 people in the Greater Philadelphia area are newly diagnosed each year. Our current regional locations are at: Alliance Cancer Specialists at Grand View, Doylestown, and Bensalem, Doylestown Health, St Mary's Medical Center Trinity Health, CSCGP at Ridgeland Mansion Philadelphia and CSCGP at Gilda's Club, Warminster.

Today, we stand strong, guided by our founding vision. We are committed to providing support and strength to our brothers, sisters, spouses, children, grandchildren, friends, colleagues, and neighbors, all at no cost. We are one community, and together, we support them.

Your gifts allow Cancer Support Community Greater Philadelphia to provide individual and group counseling, health and wellness classes, educational events and social gatherings, all at no cost to our members. We embrace and uplift people impacted by cancer, together.

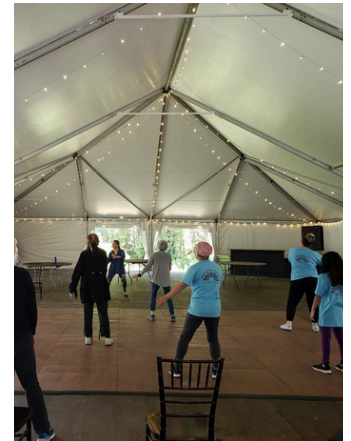
CAMP DISCOVERY

We were delighted to host Camp KIDS at Gilda's Club in Warminster this past summer, providing our members with a memorable day camp experience. Camp KIDS offered a range of activities including games, crafts, visits from an ice cream truck, and themed days like 50's Day, Alien Encounter, Medieval Days, Pirate, Game Show, Survivor Days, and our popular water wars. Additionally, we introduced Teen Camp exclusively for participants aged 13 and older. These programs offer an opportunity for kids to be together, that share similar experiences whether they have a cancer diagnosis, a mother, father, or sibling. It is a chance to have fun and give their caregivers an opportunity for respite and guarantees their children a day of fun, at no cost to them.



TEEN ESSAY CONTEST

Annually, the Ben Strauss Youth Program sponsors an essay contest to provide a platform for young writers to share their perspectives on cancer and its impact. Open to middle and high school students and beyond, the contest showcases the creativity, resilience, and empathy of the next generation. The essays are reviewed, and winners are selected, followed by an evening to celebrate our essay winners. We are proud to share the 2023 winners are Madison Stuetz and Eirinn Love.

FROM THE DESK OF BETH CRIBB, CANCER SUPPORT COMMUNITY GREATER PHILADELPHIA PROGRAM DIRECTOR

As we reflect on the past year at Cancer Support Community Greater Philadelphia, we are filled with profound gratitude and pride that over 2,000 individuals allowed us to accompany them along their cancer journey. Our vision has always been to ensure that no one faces cancer alone. Daily, we see the incredible impact that our comprehensive support programs, which includes emotional support, educational resources, wellness classes, and navigation services, provide for local families.

Navigation Assistance: Cancer often brings unexpected challenges, from financial burdens to logistical concerns. Our program team of Licensed Social Workers and Counselors, support local families with accessing necessary services, such as, transportation, nutritional support, and financial assistance, thus alleviating some of these pressures. Direct partnerships with area hospitals enables CSCGP team members to interact directly with the medical care team, which greatly enhances our ability to support those in need.

Community Engagement: We host a variety of social gatherings – from seasonal and holiday events to casual drops-ins- for people of all ages throughout the year. In addition to being fun, they provide an opportunity for those affected by cancer to connect with more individuals. Some annual favorite events include Turkey Bingo, Breakfast with Santa and summer camps for adults, kids and teens!

Health and Wellness Classes: Support looks different for everyone, and we strive to offer a diverse calendar to meet everyone where they are at a particular moment. Including a variety of nutritional, wellness and creative classes where people with cancer, along with their family members and friends, can engage in healthy lifestyle practices. In addition to an array of dietary and cooking classes, the calendar includes weekly yoga, Qigong, Pilates, and other mind-body disciplines classes. Throughout the month, there are opportunities for creative expression through writing, jewelry making, painting and other creative arts.

Emotional Support:

At CSCGP, we recognize the emotional toll a cancer diagnosis takes on the entire family. Our support groups and individual counseling services provide a nurturing environment for individuals and families to share their knowledge along with building a community around a shared experience. Frequently, group members report feeling alone with their ‘dark thoughts’. Even within the strongest family unit, individuals strive to protect their loved ones from the ‘what if’ and ‘worst case scenario’ thoughts. Support groups provide a space for processing and sharing these thoughts, thus reducing isolation and demystifying fears.

CSCGP strives to support individuals along the entire cancer continuum, which means providing opportunities for all ages, including children and teenagers as well as a variety of circumstances. For instance, support is available for those currently undergoing treatment as well as for bereaved loved ones. While we can’t be everywhere, we aim to support people in the spaces that are most comfortable for them, including at the 7 CSCGP locations, Middle & High Schools in Bucks County and in their homes, using virtual platforms.

Educational Resources:

Knowledge is power, and we are committed to equipping individuals with the information they need to make informed decisions about their care. Our educational workshops and seminars, led by medical professionals and experts, cover a range of topics from treatment options to coping strategies.

As we look ahead, we remain committed to evolving and adapting our services to meet the ever-changing needs of our community. We are excited about upcoming initiatives and continue to seek innovative ways to support those we serve. Together, this community is making a significant difference, one person at a time.

MEET STEPHEN



FINDING A SANCTUARY AND PURPOSE

In January 2020, during a routine eye check-up, Stephen's life took an unforeseen turn when he received a diagnosis of ocular melanoma, a rare and aggressive form of eye cancer. The initial treatment involved a radiation plaque targeting the primary tumor, and biannual scans to monitor for any signs of spread. Like many other cancer patients, Stephen lived in a state of tentative relief. Each clear scan was a small victory, but when a routine scan revealed that the cancer had metastasized Stephen found himself navigating a new battleground, his liver.

The new phase of his treatment involved liver-directed therapies, including immunoembolization and a weekly infusion of Kymriah immunotherapy. The physical toll was immense, but it was the emotional weight that threatened to overwhelm him. Amidst the turmoil of treatments and uncertainties, Stephen found a sanctuary at the Cancer Support Community Greater Philadelphia (CSCGP). "I don't know where I would be honestly, mentally and everything, without having participated here."

"It makes you feel like you're not going through things alone."

The interconnection between mental health and physical healing plays an important role in the battle with cancer. Stephen participated in support groups, Men's Breakfasts, and therapeutic sessions like Reiki. Stephen found he was able to escape and find moments of joy during programming and that it provided him with the respite he needed from his fight with cancer. "Your treatments and all that stuff are only going to work as well as you feel good about things,"

At Cancer Support Community, Stephen found support, but it also fostered his drive to contribute to our organization. He immediately wanted to give back to our organization. Despite his physical challenges, he volunteered for landscaping duties at CSCGP. "It gives me a sense of purpose," Stephen shared that even his wife has observed the remarkable transformation in his demeanor. When he heads to Gilda's Club, he is anxious and distressed, but upon returning home, he is noticeably lighter and more content. Without the program and staff here "I would definitely be totally isolated."

For Stephen, CSCGP is more than an organization; it is family. Everyone is welcomed here, everything is free, and accessible services alleviated his financial stress, allowing him and his family the time to focus on healing.

As Stephen continues to face his challenges with strength, his story underscores the strength one can gain from the support of CSCGP community; both from the perspective of someone who received help and gave back to us. "I love to come down here and do this stuff because when I'm here and I'm doing it, it gets me out of my sickness." At CSCGP we love to hear we made an impact on our members' lives, and we are blessed with many returning their gift by becoming our volunteers.

FINDING STRENGTH IN COMMUNITY

Fanella's family life changed in May 2020, when her husband, Bill, was diagnosed with esophageal cancer. He had already faced prostate cancer the previous year and as a physician himself, understood the likely outcome of his new diagnosis. Despite this, Bill fought valiantly, undergoing various treatments and trials while Fanella became his primary caregiver, a role that required strength and resilience.

Bill's love for his family was unwavering. He spent his good days with Fanella and their boys, cherishing every moment. His dedication to his work persisted until his final days, highlighting his passion for science and problem-solving. Even as he approached the end of his life, Bill prepared Fanella and the boys for his absence, writing letters and making videos for his children.

On May 29, 2021, Bill was rushed to the hospital with difficulty breathing. Fanella stood by his side, honoring his wish not to be placed on a ventilator. She fought to bring him home, where he passed away on June 3, 2021. His passing was both heart-wrenching and beautiful. In his final moments, Fanella played "Good Night" by the Beatles, a song Bill often sang to their boys. As the song played, Bill took his last breath, bringing Fanella a sense of peace amidst the sorrow.

During this challenging time, a neighbor who had previously battled breast cancer recommended CSCGP to Fanella, believing it would be beneficial for her and her family. Fanella decided to join for the sake of her boys. Initially, she participated in various online programs due to the COVID-19 pandemic, such as yoga, group therapy, journal writing, cooking, and meditation. As for her three boys, they eagerly attended Kids Camp, group therapy, arcade outings, holiday events like Easter egg hunts and Christmas in July, and even horseback riding. These activities became cherished parts of their lives. It brought her children fun moments, support opportunities and community.

Fanella shared "it was important to me that my boys felt comfortable in their therapy. I mean, everyone's different. But they talk here. And when we talk about it at home, they feel comfortable sharing. They've told me they like being here because they know there's no reason to shy away. You can say your dad passed away. And it'd be okay."

Fanella's family has been coming to CSCGP for almost three years. The community here has provided her boys with a safe space to express themselves and connect with others facing similar struggles. "The people who are here supporting the families, they are familiar and aware of the emotional roller coaster. Not just the parents, but the children. It's difficult for us parents to realize that so much because we are raising them. The support here, people can acknowledge that." Christina (Children/Teen Program Manager) has a remarkable ability to make people feel welcomed and has made a significant difference for Fanella and her family. In some organizations, you're turned away after one or two years, but here we are welcomed. It never feels like the time to grieve has expired; this enduring support is what makes CSCGP so special.

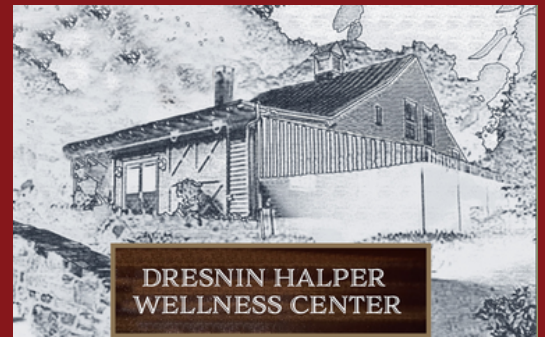
GALA
